May 18 is International Day for Women in Maritime, which recognizes the importance of women in the ocean transport industry. The theme for 2025 was “An Ocean of Opportunities for Women.” In Taiwan, women represent only 4% of seafarers (航海人員). 21 the 260 women seafarers, many have proved that seafaring can be a rewarding career. One woman who shows the way is Huang Chao-ling (黃昭玲). Huang, who was a captain, is Taiwan’s first and only female harbor pilot. As a harbor pilot, she guides ships safely in and out of the port, which is a 22 job that requires taking risks, such as climbing onto a moving ship in big waves. Another front-runner is Lin Chia-ling (林嘉玲), Taiwan’s first woman oil tanker captain. Lin’s job is to ensure reliable delivery of oil to all ports in Taiwan, 23 the weather is terrible. Huang and Lin share a hard career path, given that women seafarers face various challenges, including insufficient onboard facilities. Today, the maritime industry is working to create a gender-friendly workplace 24. Such efforts are seeing results, with the number of Taiwanese women captains standing at 22 in 2024, up from 6 about ten years ago.

The Tamkang Bridge (淡江大橋) has been under construction since 2019 and is ready for use this year. It was built because the Tamsui (淡水) and Bali (八里) areas have grown quickly in recent years, and more people now commute between them. Once it opens, people can save about half an hour when traveling between the two places. Besides making 25 smooth, the bridge will also appeal to visitors with its special architectural style. It was designed by the world-famous architect Zaha Hadid. Being the first bridge in Taiwan 26 through an international design competition, the Tamkang Bridge will become the world’s longest single-tower asymmetric cable-stayed bridge (單塔不對稱斜張橋). Expressing a sense of art and beauty, the bridge’s 200-meter tower rises into the sky, 27 a dancer were lifting both hands in prayer. Moreover, the bridge’s shape goes well with the sunset over the Tamsui River, making the view much more eye-catching. Visitors can appreciate the riverside views here. With shorter travel time between Tamsui and Bali and its unique beauty, the Tamkang Bridge will play an important role in both 28. The bridge will definitely bring travel convenience and recreational benefits to the people of northern Taiwan.

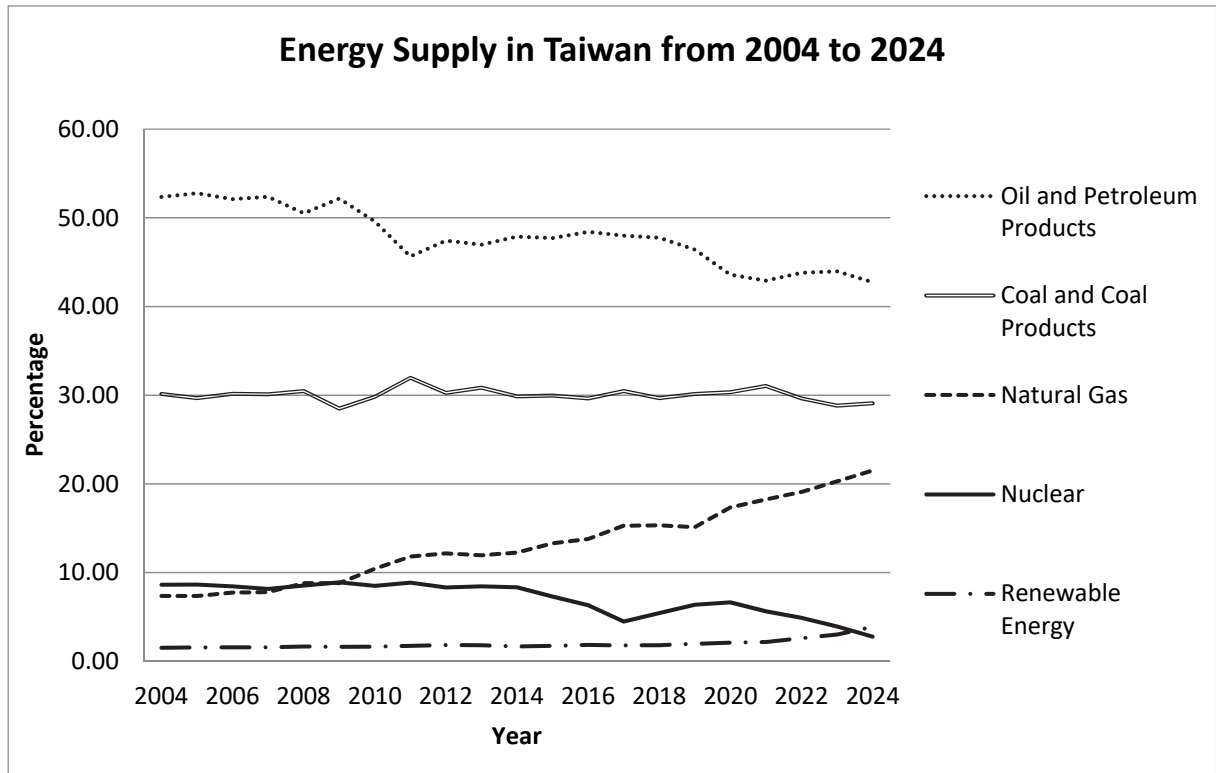

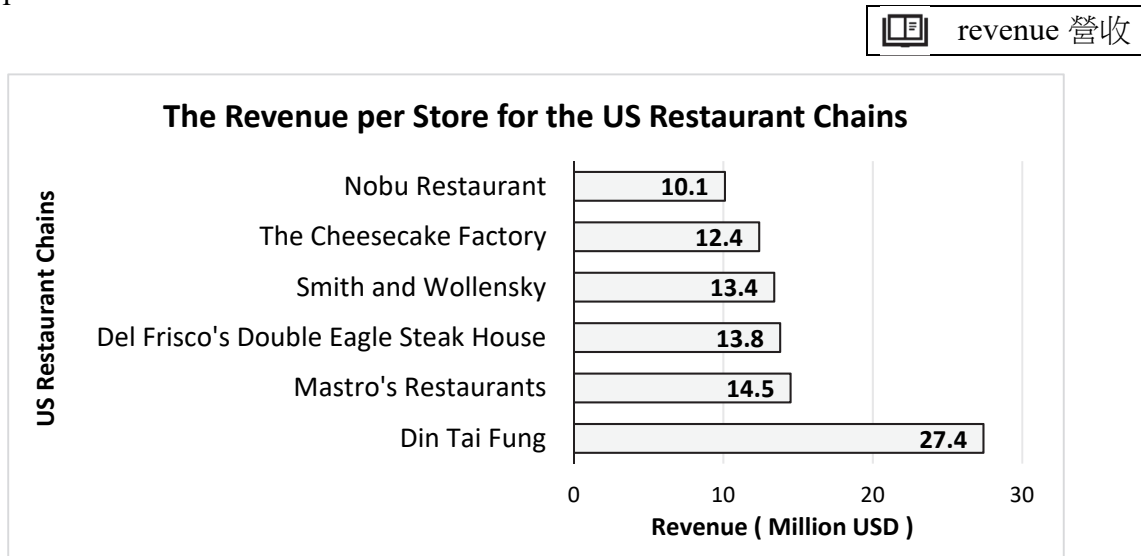

Founded in 1958 in Taiwan as a cooking oil business, Din Tai Fung began selling *xiao long bao* in 1972 in Taipei. About 25 years later, it opened its first American branch store in Los Angeles. Over the years, it has expanded to 180 branch stores in 13 countries around the world.

Din Tai Fung's success was not achieved through expensive ads. Instead, the restaurant chain has built its brand on global consistent product excellence, operational discipline, and social media buzz. Whether in Los Angeles or Taipei, customers experience the same taste and service. Every Din Tai Fung *xiao long bao* is folded exactly 18 times and weighs precisely 21 grams. Through glass walls, customers can see chefs in the kitchen, making *xiao long bao* with exactness and care. The way the chefs make the food, the steam coming off the baskets, and the perfect look of each dish all make for great photos and videos. Customers post the pictures and share their dining experience widely online, giving the brand effective publicity. The consistent quality, combined with visual pleasure and the power of social media, has made Din Tai Fung successful and popular in the US.

Recent studies show that teenagers experience more anxiety and mental health issues than those in earlier generations. In his book *The Anxious Generation: How the Great Rewiring of Childhood Is Causing an Epidemic of Mental Illness*, Professor Jonathan Haidt explains that two major changes in childhood are mainly responsible for their problems.

First, these young people lost real-world freedom during childhood. Their parents tended to protect them too much and carefully control their daily activities. They were not encouraged to explore outdoors, take risks, and solve problems independently. As a result, they might have missed many opportunities to develop confidence and independence. According to Professor Haidt, plenty of free, unsupervised outdoor play is important for healthy development. Without outdoor play, children may be less willing to try new things as they grow into teenagers.

Another major change is the shift from a play-based childhood to a phone-based one. Since childhood, these young people have often spent many hours using smartphones and social media for leisure activities. This leads to several problems. For example, they do not get enough sleep because of long hours on screens. Instead of interacting face to face, they often communicate online, making them feel less connected to people in the real world. Also, constant phone messages and addictive apps make it hard for them to stay focused. When they cannot check their phones, they feel anxious.

Taiwan is a global high-tech powerhouse because of its dynamic industries. Of these, the electronics industry is best known for its importance in the digital age. This industry has a competitive strength which was built from years of developing expertise in electronics manufacturing.

Electronics manufacturing in Taiwan began around the mid-20th century. Initially, companies produced mainly components according to customers' designs and requirements, functioning as contract manufacturers for other brands. In the process, they learned to adapt, innovate, and compete. By the 1990s, Taiwan had become a global leader in computer and notebook production. Major manufacturers developed the expert skills and knowledge for product designing and innovation. Today, some of them are able to provide a full range of electronics manufacturing services (EMS). These EMS providers serve various industries that include computing, communications, and consumer electronics. Four Taiwanese manufacturers have made it onto the list of the world's top ten EMS providers.

Taiwan's electronics industry owes its success to several factors. First, there is a ready pool of professionals to meet industry needs. Secondly, official policies provide the necessary industrial support. Thirdly, a wide network of local suppliers adds to better efficiency and innovation. Last but not least, manufacturers pay special attention to producing high-quality products, rather than competing on price.

Currently, the great demand for AI products offers new business opportunities. Manufacturers who **ride the wave of change** are making more money from AI servers than from iPhones. For the first time, AI-related products have beaten consumer electronics in manufacturing business. In fact, Taiwan made over 80 percent of the world's AI servers (伺服器) in 2025. Quite clearly, this demonstrates the ability of Taiwan's electronics industry to move forward with technology.



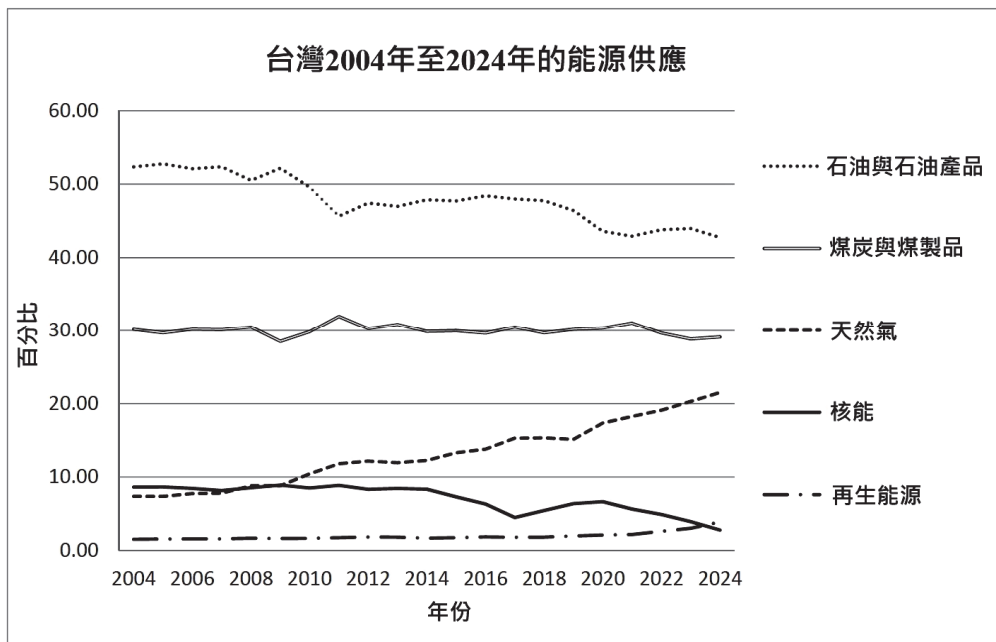

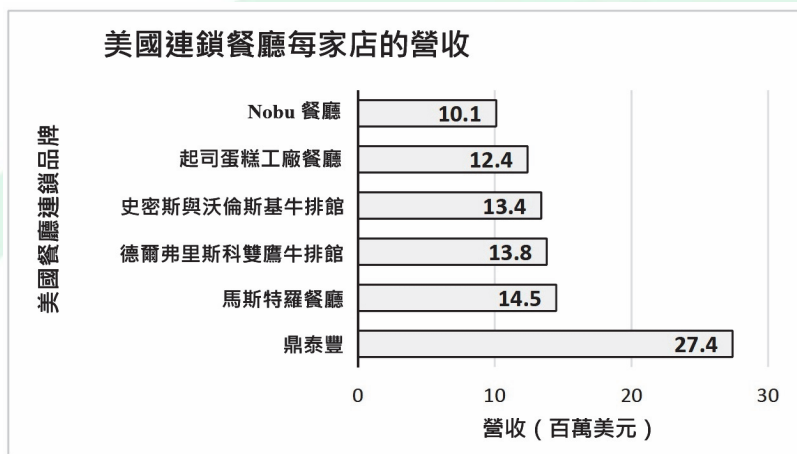

最近研究顯示，青少年比更早之前的世代經歷了更多焦慮跟心理健康的問題。

*Professor Jonathan Haidt 在他的書中，焦慮的世代：童年數位大改造導致了心理疾病，他解釋說有兩個重大的改變造成了他們的這些問題。*

首先，這些年輕人在童年就失去了真實世界中的自由。他們的父母親容易過度保護他們並且小心的控制他們的日常生活。他們不被鼓勵去探索戶外冒險或是獨立解決問題。因此，他們也許錯過許多發展自信跟獨立的機會。根據 Professor Jonathan Haidt，在戶外自由不受監控的玩耍對健康發展是重要的。沒有了戶外遊玩小孩也許在變成青少年時比較不願意去嘗試新的事物。

另一個主要的改變就是從一個以玩樂為基底的童年變成以手機為主的童年。從小，這些小孩就花很多時間在使用手機跟社交媒體把它們當成休閒活動。這導致了一些問題。例如，他們因為長時間看螢幕沒有足夠睡眠。沒有面對面互動，他們反而經常在網路上跟人溝通，使得他們感到在真實世界中比較少跟人有連結。還有常態的手機訊息跟讓人成癮的手機應用程式也讓他們很難專心。當他們無法查看手機，他們就會焦慮。

台灣因為它的動態產業而成為全球高科技的科技巨擘。在這些產業當中，電子業在數位時代更是以它的重要性為人所熟知。這個產業擁有強大的競爭優勢，這是多年來在電子製造領域累積專業技術的結果。

台灣的電子製造業大約始於 20 世紀中葉。最初，這些公司主要根據客戶的設計和要求生產零組件，擔任其他品牌的合約製造商。在這個過程中，他們學會了適應、創新和競爭。到了 1990 年代，台灣已成為全球電腦和筆記型電腦的生產領導者。

主要製造商已發展出產品設計與創新的專業技能與知識。如今，其中一些企業能夠提供全方位的電子製造服務(EMS)。這些 EMS 供應商服務於各個產業，包括計算機、通訊和消費性電子產品。四家台灣製造商已躋身全球前十大 EMS 供應商之列。

台灣電子產業的成功歸功於以下幾個因素。首先，有充足的專業人才庫來滿足產業需求。其次，官方政策提供了必要的產業支持。第三，廣泛的本土供應商網絡提高了效率和創新能力。最後但同樣重要的是，製造商特別注重生產高品質的產品，而不是依賴價格競爭。

目前，人工智慧(AI)產品的巨大需求帶來了新的商業機會。把握這波變革浪潮的製造商，從 AI 伺服器賺取的利潤已經超過了 iPhone。AI 相關產品在製造業務中的營收首次擊敗了消費性電子產品。
